The February Review and Confirm window has been open between 1st February -14th February 2025.

AIM Level 5 Equipment - Transfer of Ownership



The 'Transfer of Ownership' process for AIM Level 5 equipment will open this month on the Hive. The Transfer of Ownership of relevant AIM equipment, from Pobal and DCEDIY to the relevant party, occurs at the end of the child's participation in the ECCE programme. The completion of this process will determine the destination and ownership of the AIM Level 5 equipment item.

As per the AIM rules, section 7.20 "ELC services and parent(s)/guardian(s) must engage with Pobal in relation to the transfer of ownership of equipment (including returning signed transfer of ownership forms, as appropriate)".

Equipment provided under AIM Level 5 should **not** be removed from the pre-school until the transfer of ownership process is completed. Guides and training videos are available in the Help & Support section on the Early Years Hive.

Reporting Requirements for Core Funding Year 2

The deadline for submitting the completed Income and Expenditure for Year 2, is 28th February 2025.

New Garda Vetting procedures

Tusla will now provide the Garda Vetting Application Service for Registered Providers of Early Years & School Age Childcare Services, Childminders, and those applying for registration.

Applications must be submitted via the new <u>Tusla Garda Vetting</u> <u>Portal</u>.

To support Registered Providers and Childminders Tusla has created a *dedicated* Garda Vetting section on their website, along with a Guidance Document, FAQ and a <u>pathway infographic</u>.

Please note Tusla will *not* provide vetting for employees, volunteers, or cover personnel in childcare services. Vetting for these staff members *must* be obtained from <u>Early Childhood</u> <u>Ireland</u>. Students on work placement must apply through their educational institution.





Childminding Development Grant 2025

Norma Foley, Minister for Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth, recently announced the opening of the 2025 Childminding Development Grant.

The total budget of €500,000 reflects the high demand for the grant in previous years. It also reflects the Government's commitment to support childminders to prepare for registration with Tusla.

The Childminding Development Grant of up to €1,000 is open to all childminders, including those who are planning to open a childminding business in 2025. The grant aims to support childminders to enhance quality and safety in their service through the purchase of toys, childcare equipment, safety equipment, equipment to support inclusion and STEAM education (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Maths), as well as IT equipment to assist childminders to engage with training and registration processes later in the year.

Applications for the Childminding Development Grant are made to Cavan County Childcare Committee. The grant application window is from 4th February 2025 to 4th April 2025.

Lifestart: The Growing Child Programme

The Growing Child Programme is designed to support and educate parents/carers on how their children will learn and develop in the early years. To assist with the child's preparation for life a month by month Growing Child Issue and Flashcards are supported with age and stage appropriate educational resources such as sound makers, books, jigsaws and art and craft materials. This **free** programme is currently available for parents/carers in in the areas of Clones and north county Monaghan and are delighted to see the programme expand into County Cavan for children from birth until 3 years old.

The Growing Child Programme is delivered in the family home each month by a Family Visitor. She will talk to parents/carers about their child's development; what to expect over the next month and what they can do with the child to help him or her reach the age-appropriate developmental milestones.

The Family Visitor provides an informed, supportive and respectful role. The monthly home visit creates an opportunity to:

- Understand about the child's stage of development
- Learn how to encourage this development
- Talk about the achievements of the family

Discuss any concerns the parent/carer may have
