The deadline for submitting the completed Income and Expenditure for Year 2 is 28th February 2025.

AIM Level 5 Equipment - Transfer of Ownership



The 'Transfer of Ownership' process for AIM Level 5 equipment will open on 28th February on the Hive. The Transfer of Ownership of relevant AIM equipment, from Pobal and DCEDIY to the relevant party, occurs at the end of the child's participation in the ECCE programme.

Equipment provided under AIM Level 5 should not be removed from the pre-school until the transfer of ownership process is completed.

Due to the temporary closure of settings over the midterm break, LINC have decided to extend the application deadline for the highly sought-after LINC+ CPD Programme.


You now have until Friday, February 28th at 4pm to submit your application

The programme is fully funded by the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth and is delivered completely online.

New Garda Vetting procedures

Tusla will now provide the Garda Vetting Application Service for people who are Registered Providers of Early Years Services (including Childminders) or those applying for registration.

Who Can Apply through Tusla from February 2025?

Tusla will provide Garda Vetting for:

- Registered Providers of pre-school and school-age services
- Childminders
- Heads of Boards of Management (where the person is the Registered Provider)
- Quality assurance personnel acting on behalf of the chairperson



Who Cannot Apply through Tusla?

Tusla will not provide vetting for:

- Employees, volunteers, or cover personnel in childcare services
- Students on placement (must apply through their educational institution)

Vetting for these staff members must be obtained from Early Childhood Ireland.

Applications must be submitted via the new [Tusla Garda Vetting Portal](#). Guidance materials will be available to support applicants.

Childminding Development Grants 2025

Norma Foley, Minister for Children, Disability and Equality announced the opening of the 2025 Childminding Development Grant.

The Childminding Development Grant provides up to €1,000 to assist both registered and unregistered childminders who are providing a childminding service in their own homes.

The grant aims to support childminders to enhance quality and safety in their service through the purchase of toys, childcare equipment, safety equipment, equipment to support inclusion and Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Maths (STEAM) education, as well as IT equipment to assist childminders to engage with training and registration processes.

The grant scheme is open to all childminders, including those who are planning to open a childminding business during 2025. 75% of the grant is paid in advance to help childminders with the upfront costs of purchasing equipment.
