WHAT IS A PARENT & TODDLER GROUP?

Parent and toddler groups are where parents and carers of young children can come together socially, usually one morning a week. This usually takes place in a child centered environment. Parent and toddler groups offer opportunities to engage in play activities with children while socialising and networking with parents. Parents and carers are responsible for their children throughout the session and the overall organisation is a shared responsibility.

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM A PARENT & TODDLER GROUP

No two parent and toddler groups are the same. There will always be variations among the children, adults and the environments. Parent and Toddler groups and local support groups are where adults and children can meet people and develop friendships. Parent and toddler groups are run in a safe and friendly environment where interaction and socialising is usually experienced.

Parents and carers are very important to parent and toddler groups. Each parent / carer is responsible for their child throughout each session.

ADVANTAGES OF A PARENT AND TODDLER GROUP

Both children and adults are socially integrated. They operate during term time so are convenient. The children get the opportunity to socialise and interact with peers enabling them to develop socially and gain confidence within the group. They can be a good starting point to preparing your child for some form of daycare.

Children get the opportunity to play with new toys and join in activities with new people in a new environment. Adults get the opportunity to socialise with each other and to learn from each others experiences. It alleviates the isolation often felt by those caring for very young children.
