Tusla Registration Renewal

We encourage all services to check the <u>Early Years</u> register or <u>School Age register</u> or your current Tusla certificate to confirm your current registration date.

Services are required to complete a registration renewal *every 3 years*. Services are required to have a completed application submitted on the Tusla portal 2 months before the expiry of the current registration date.

Tusla facilitate registration renewals up to 6 months in advance of the current registration date. It is advised that you apply for updated Garda Vetting in a timely manner.

Due to the recently implemented changes to Garda Vetting procedures, the process may take extra time.
