Tusla Registration Renewal

All service providers are encouraged to check the <u>Early</u> <u>Years register</u> or the <u>School Age register</u>, and to confirm their re-registration date.

Please note the following key points:

- Re-registration can be completed up to 6 months in advance of your expiry date.
- Applications must be submitted no later than 2 months before your current certification expires.
- Please be mindful of recent changes to <u>Garda</u>
 <u>Vetting Procedures</u> and ensure you have adequate time.

Failure to re-register in time will result in your **removal** from the register and it is an offence to operate an unregistered service.

Garda National Vetting Bureau (GNBV) Affiliate Registration Number

Garda Vetting timelines to meet European Criminal Records Information System (ECRIS) requirement

The Garda National Vetting Bureau have communicated *current processing times are 8 to 10 working days* (from when the applicant completes the link). Additional checks are required for anyone who has lived outside of Ireland for more than 6 months

- Up to 10 additional working days for EU countries
- Up to 20 additional working days for the UK

Police Clearance Certificates are still required.
