NCS 2025/26 Funding Agreement

The new National Childcare Scheme (NCS) year begins on 18 August 2025. You must activate the NCS 2025/2026 funding agreement before the current agreement ends to ensure ongoing participation, as claims on NCS CHICKs will be registered across both programme years.

Funding cannot be backdated, so please submit this application promptly. For further guidelines, visit <u>Early</u> <u>Years Hive</u>.

QIPP Report Template 2024/2025

The deadline for completing the QIPP end of year report is **Thursday 31 July 2025** on <u>www.cfcrrs.ie</u>.

Late-evening and weekend school-age childcare

Under the <u>2025/2026 Funding Agreement</u>, school-age childcare provided after 7pm on working days and weekend school-age childcare will no longer qualify for NCS subsidies.

Exceptions may be granted at the Department's discretion. Providers should contact their local CCC for details.

Tusla Registration and NCS subsidies

A child within a service transitioning from ECCE to Junior Infants, will **not** be regarded as a School-Aged child *until they have commenced school*.


When registering a child, there will be an automatic system check to ensure that you hold the relevant Tusla certification for the child's education stage: early years and/or school-age childcare.



Weather Guidance

The Tusla Early Years Inspectorate has issued comprehensive guidance for early years services to ensure children are kept safe and comfortable both indoors and outdoors in all weathers. The document is available here.

Learner Fund Graduate and Childminder Bursary 2025

Applications for the Learner Fund Graduate Bursary and the Learner Fund Childminder Bursary will be accepted from 15 September 2025 to 17 October 2025.

Tusla Registration Renewal

All service providers are encouraged to check the <u>Early</u> <u>Years register</u> or the <u>School Age register</u>, and to confirm their re-registration date.

Please note the following key points:

- Re-registration can be completed up to 6 months in advance of your expiry date.
- Applications must be submitted no later than 2 months before your current certification expires.
- Please be mindful of recent changes to <u>Garda</u>
 <u>Vetting Procedures</u> and ensure you have adequate time.

Failure to re-register in time will result in your **removal** from the register and it is an offence to operate an unregistered service.

IMPORTAN Updated Garda Vetting

There is a **new** Garda Vetting process in place for ELC/SAC services since 1st **February 2025**, and *it can take over 2 months to complete*.

The following now applies:

- TUSLA manage Garda Vetting services for registered providers, including childminders, as well as Chairpersons of Boards of Management (where they are the registered provider) and board members who have access to children. Further information is available here.
- Early Childhood Ireland (ECI) manage Garda Vetting services for all employees in ELC and SAC services. For more information, go to the ECI website.
- Barnardos no longer provide vetting services.
