New action plans for the Early Learning and Care and School-Age Childcare Sector

Two new action plans for the early learning and care and school-age childcare sector have been published by Minister Foley. The <u>'Shaping the Future: Early Years Action Plan'</u> commits to actions in 2026 to make services more affordable, accessible and improve quality.

The <u>'Simplify and Support: Action Plan for Simplification'</u> will streamline administration and regulation, helping providers, educators, practitioners and parents navigate the system more easily.

What's New for 2026 - Employee Assistance Programme (EAP)

Recently announced in the Budget 2026 to support welfare and wellness of the early learning and care and school age childcare workforce, a pilot employee assistance programme would be funded in five City/County Childcare Committee areas, Cork City, Cork County, Longford, Meath and Cavan.

Following evaluation of this pilot programme, it is the intention to expand this programme across the sector offering this valuable resource and support to the workforce for times of difficulty both personally and professionally.

NCS maintenance- End of Year 2025

It may be necessary to make important changes for the NCS on HIVE as the year comes to an end.

NCS Calendar:

All service closures must be marked on your NCS calendar, closures must be marked as subsidised or not. Retrospective changes cannot be made to the NCS calendar

NCS Weekly Returns:

Weekly reporting requirements remain in place during the Christmas and New Year period.

NCS Bridging Payments:

Services closed for one full week or two consecutive weeks and at least one of the days in this period is designated as a subsidised closure, will be given the option to request a bridging provision of the closed week(s) on the NCS Return one week before closure.

Grace Period:

Services who missed the opportunity to avail of a bridging payment can apply for a grace period payment if they are unable to submit an NCS return due to closure.

Core funding Compliance

AIM Level 1 Non-term Payments

AIM Non-term payments will be made over Christmas for children in the NCS with an active AIM Level 7 Non-term application.

Many services may be closed during this period per the ECCE calendar but AIM Level 7 payments follow the NCS calendar open days.

Payments for Non-term capitations will only occur if there is a corresponding NCS claim and AIM Level 7 does not cover subsidized closure periods under NCS.
